The role of Electrician and Critical Risk Management Officer requires attention to detail, management skills and a thorough understanding of the Royal Australian Navy's ships systems, policies, procedures along with Prime Contractor requirements. This role is required to conduct electrical tasks and manage other team members (as directed) in the conduct of general tasks as directed by the Operations Manager.

This position is required to perform the duties of an Electrician, which includes but is not limited to the conduct of electrical maintenance tasks in a marine environment, fault finding and electrical installations. The Critical Risk Management Officer component of the role involves the issuing of permits and electrical isolations. This role may also require the individual to conduct travel interstate and as required to meet customer requirements (planned and unplanned). This individual is required to represent Ausbright and must demonstrate and maintain high work, safety, security, and electrical standards.

#### **Your duties will include:**

- Implementing OH&S procedures and 'driving' the safety culture within Ausbright following safe working practices at all times. Communicate any safety concerns to other team members and supervisors immediately.
- Follow Policies, Procedures and legislation as applicable.
- Communicate effectively with other team members and ensure quality workmanship is produced.
